Sport Parachute Association of Saskatchewan and Skydive Saskatoon will be hosting the annual Provincial Jump Meet on July 3 – 4, 2021

- When:** Friday, July 2 @ 7:30PM = Dropzone Check-In and Brief followed by Happy Hour
Saturday, July 3 @ 7:30AM = Dropzone Check-In and Brief followed by Competition
Sunday, July 4 @ 8:30AM = Competition continues followed by Awards around 3PM
- Where:** Skydive Saskatoon is hosting @ Saskatoon/Richter Field Aerodrome – 639.998.JUMP
- Why:** Annual competition and get together for jumpers from Saskatchewan and beyond that are members of the Sport Parachute Association of Saskatchewan. Dropzone Happy Hour on Friday evening. Saturday's Competition will be followed by dinner provided by SPAS, please let SPAS BoD know at bod@skydive.sk.ca if you have any food allergies or other special dietary needs and we can try to accommodate. (Dinner will be decided on closer to the date pending covid restrictions around service of food). Sunday Competition followed by an Awards Ceremony at 3PM.
- How:** Use the QR code to register or go to provincials.skydive.ca. Create an account & throwaway password (do not use a password that is important to you as the form is not secure). Pick your event(s) from the list below and pay the appropriate amount. Payment is secure as its processed through Authorize.Net. You must register to participate!

Dropzone Info: There is plenty of space for tents and camper parking on site. There is a porta potty and an enclosed shower area... must provide your own solar shower. Sorry there is no running water or electric hook ups. Absolutely NO campfires per airport owner.

Covid Info: Per Sask Health, masks are required in the hangar and in the jump plane - **NO EXCEPTIONS** – and are encouraged outside when social distancing is not possible. In addition, there is a 30 person max limit in the hangar at any time and a 150 person max on the airport grounds.

Notes: ALL participants MUST attend a registration session and dropzone safety brief prior to jump. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Those unable to attend the scheduled briefings will be handled on a case by case basis when time allows.

The dropzone will be open for tent/camper set up beginning at 12pm on Friday, July 2. There is no jumping on that Friday July 2nd.

NO Fun Jumping. If you register for an event, please give forth your best effort on all jumps.

Videos must be presented to the designated dubbing station upon landing in order to be judged.

Participants must arrange their own videographers, 3way teams and VFS teams.

There will be student gear from both dropzones available for use to assist with comfort levels for students.

Jump Masters, Ground Control Instructors are asked to let manifest know they can help dispatch students from their home dropzone.

No alcohol prior to the end of the jumping day on Saturday and Sunday.
